1. French Studies Fellowship – (DEADLINE – January 12, 2008)

Synopsis – Applications from scholars pursuing studies in the humanities and social sciences related to French and Francophone cultures and from composers, writers, and visual artists pursuing specific projects, for residential fellowships at the Camargo Foundation's center in Cassis, France.

2. Mississippi Humanities Council – Minigrants (DEADLINE – September 1, 2007)

Synopsis - MINIGRANTS Requests of \$2,000 or less are considered minigrants. Minigrants must be submitted at least eight weeks in advance of the program date. Deadlines for submitting Minigrant requests are January 1, March 1, May 1, July 1, September 1, and November 1. Two copies with original signatures and five additional copies are required. One copy of other supporting materials should be submitted.
