Background

- Federal Demonstration Partnership (FDP)
- FDP was looking for better, more efficient ways to manage awards.
- Originally the "FDP Terms and Conditions".
- FDP Member Institutions had permission to use these special terms and conditions.
- AKA "Expanded Authorities"





Background (cont.)

- After a period of time with successful use, morphed into Federal-wide Terms and Conditions.
- Aspired to reduce burdens and add consistency to requirements among agencies.
- Prior to Uniform Guidance, previous RTCs implemented OMB Circular A-110.
- Became outdated upon Uniform Guidance.



New Research Terms & Conditions (RTCs)

- Research Business Models working group: interagency working group under the National Science and Technology Council.
- Implement Uniform Guidance and provide clarity for select provisions.
- Implement by reference the OMB FAQs.
- Apply to research and research-related grants made by participating agencies to universities and non-profits.




When Do the RTCs Apply?

- Research and researchrelated grants made by participating agencies to institutions of higher education and non-profit organizations.
- Must be included as part of the award or incorporated into the award by reference.

Order of Precedence

- Award-specific terms and conditions
- Federal Agency's program-specific terms and conditions
- Federal Agency's general terms and conditions
- Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost
 Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal
 Awards (2 CFR 200)



Companion Documents

- Appendix A: Prior Approval Matrix
 - Includes every prior approval requirement, validated by participating agencies.
- Appendix B: Subaward Requirements Matrix
 - Addresses flow-down requirements by type of subrecipient, validated by participating agencies.
- Appendix C: National Policy Requirements Matrix
- Agency-Specific Requirements



Prior Approval Highlights

- Requires prior approval for:
 - Change in scope or objectives.
 - Disengagement of PI (permanently or continuous period of >3 months or 25% reduction in time).
 - Transfer of funds for <u>participant</u> <u>support costs</u> to other categories of expense.
 - Transfer of <u>significant part of</u>
 <u>research</u> or substantive
 programmatic effort (with some exceptions).





Prior Approval Highlights (cont.)

- Allows the following without prior approval:
 - Pre-award costs up to 90 days prior to award (incurred at risk).
 - One-time extension of 12 months if:
 - Agency-specific requirements do not prohibit.
 - Extension does not require additional federal funds.
 - Extension does not involve change in scope/objectives.
 - <u>Carryforward</u> of unobligated balances to subsequent funding periods.
 - Transfer between indirect/direct costs.
