ACADEMIC ADMINISTRATIVE EXPERIENCE

Senior Advisor for European and Data Science Development, Mississippi State University, 2020-present

This position reports directly to the Provost and the Vice President for Research and Economic Development and was specifically developed to promote academic innovations that leverage the strengths of departments and colleges across campus. The position's main responsibility is to expand the international footprint of the university and to grow the university through the advancement of the state-of-the-art in data science across disciplines on campus. In this latter role, the position promotes innovation through cooperation around data science research, academic program strategy, student program-of-study coordination, and experiential learning. Recent accomplishments include the establishment of three major academic programs: (1) The intercollege Bachelor of Science in Data Science that includes nine major concentrations and the participation of eight colleges; (2) The interdisciplinary Master of Science in Data Science with a main focus on computational analytics that involves the participation two departments—Mathematics and Statistics and Computer Science, and (3) The Graduate Certificate in Data Science Pedagogy housed in the Office of Academic Affairs and designed to assist the community college system by preparing their instructors to integrate data science across academic and workforce program curricula. A key part of this position also relates to helping students to create a plan for success and to access an advising strategy that ensures success both within academic

departments and in interdisciplinary contexts. Other recent accomplishments include the establishment of a formal partnership with the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) and the World Food Program of the United Nations (WFP) and the FAO designation of Mississippi State as a center of excellence in aquaculture. All three activities are part of the university's commitment to support the achievement of the UN sustainable goals with a particular focus on providing expertise to reduce poverty and achieve zero hunger in the world. Several other partnerships with European institutions have been established that focus on expanding international expertise in data science and sustainable agriculture.

Founder and Executive Director, National Strategic Planning & Analysis Research Center (NSPARC), Mississippi State University, 2007-2018

NSPARC is a university-wide research center with the main mission to promote and advance the state-of-the-art in data science and to facilitate digital transformation in the public and private sectors. Between 2007 and 2018 NSPARC secured more than \$150 million in extramural funding to support cutting-edge research. The center also developed an information technology infrastructure to facilitate interdisciplinary research across fields ranging from philosophy and sociology to engineering. The center provides project-based learning experiences for undergraduate and graduate students and mentors young faculty in a multidisciplinary context. The center also functions as a bridge between academic departments and other research units on campus.

GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT EXPERIENCE

Founder and Executive Director, State Longitudinal Data System Data Clearinghouse, State of Mississippi, 2013-2018

The State Longitudinal Data System (SLDS) was created by the Mississippi Legislature to provide research expertise for the development of practical solutions for state government. The Executive Director is responsible for the operation and management of the system and the execution of all directives of the board and the legislature. The Executive Director oversees the data lifecycle for more than 25 state agencies. Under the leadership of the Executive Director, the SLDS has been recognized as one of the best data systems in the nation in the use of data for policy development and strategic planning in all areas of the public sector (<https://lifetracks.ms.gov>).

Developed and established the Mississippi Unified Workforce System, 2012-2020

When Governor Phill Bryant became governor in 2012, I was invited to join his team to lead the development and establishment of a state unified data system to align education and workforce activities from early childhood through retirement. My main responsibility was to support the digital transformation of agencies to improve coordination, program outcomes, and customer service through a unified vision and cultural environment. In the wake of the 2014 reauthorization of the Workforce Innovation Act, Mississippi created the most advanced digital platform for connecting citizens to government services in an interagency context. Mississippi's approach to the 2014 Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act was a model for other states in how to connect and use data across agencies in real time to increase efficiency. A major economic development outcome of this work was the instrumentality of data in attracting investments from Yokohama and Continental Tire in Mississippi.

Developed and established the Mississippi Accountability System, 2004-2012

When Governor Haley Barbour became governor in 2004, one of his priorities was to develop an accountability system to improve education and workforce outcomes. Here, my primary responsibility

was to work with a newly created State Workforce Investment Board (SWIB), the Mississippi Community College Board, all 15 community colleges, and Mississippi's Institutions of Higher Learning to create a common governance for data sharing so that program outcomes could be lined up with funding streams. The system evolved to become a performance-based management and budgeting system used to allocate resources for workforce, education, and economic development. This system was the model and proof-of-concept for the eventual development of the Mississippi State Longitudinal Data System. Another responsibility was to help the state promote economic development. A major economic development outcome was to assist in recruiting Toyota and helping Mississippi become an automotive manufacturing state.

INTERNATIONAL EXPERIENCE

In 2018 I was tapped by the newly elected Prime Minister of Italy to serve as President of the National labor department—Agenzia Nazionale delle Politiche Attive del Lavoro (ANPAL). The President is responsible for providing leadership and oversight for activities that exceed \$2 billion and is directly responsible for over 4,000 employees. The President is the primary interface between the central government and the 21 regional governors and international relations with European member States.
